







#### **GLOBAL SEZ EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS**



Forty-four years ago, 80 special economic zones (SEZs) in 30 countries generated barely US \$6 billion in exports and employed about 1 million people. Today, 5,000 SEZs operate in 155 countries and account for US \$600+ billion in exports and 85 million direct jobs. A large number of them are operating in developing countries.






